TYPES OF SAFETY LENSES



Glass Lenses

- Scratch Resistant
- Can be made with a corrective prescription
- If the lens is scratched, it should be replaced immediately

Plastic Lenses

- Are lightweight
- Protect against welding splatter
- Are not likely to fog



Polycarbonate Lenses



- Are lightweight
- Protect against welding splatter
- Are not likely to fog
- Can be stronger, more impact-resistant and less scratch-resistant than glass depending on the situation and the lens itself
