Be smart. Prevent vehicle theft by...

. Closing and locking all windows and doors when you park

- Parking in well-lit areas
 Never leaving the area while your vehicle is running
 Nover leaving valuables in your vehicle

Nearly HALF of theft is due to driver error like leaving keys in the ignition or leaving doors unlocked
