More than half of thefts occur in areas where vehicles are parked without attendants, such as...



Be smart. Prevent vehicle theft by...

- Closing and locking all windows and doors when you park
- Parking in well-lit areas
- Never leaving the area while your vehicle is running
- Never leaving valuables in your vehicle

Nearly **HALF** of theft is due to driver error like leaving keys in the ignition or leaving doors unlocked
