Tragic Toll of Ignored Ergonomic Practices: Strains and Sprains in Hotel Industry

In a somber incident at a luxury hotel, a dedicated housekeeper died due to complications arising from a severe musculoskeletal injury incurred on the job.

The employee, who had been serving the hotel for many years, sustained a debilitating sprain while moving heavy furniture during a routine room cleaning.

The strain, initially dismissed as a minor injury, progressively worsened due to continued physical exertion without proper medical intervention or workplace accommodation.

An investigation post-incident revealed a systemic lack of ergonomic training and inadequate provision of equipment or assistance for tasks involving heavy lifting or repetitive motion.
