## Bullying

El bullying es un tipo de violencia que se da en la escuela reiteradamente por parte de un o más alumn@s (agresores) hacia otros alumn@s (víctima) frente a la indiferencia de los demás que observan (espectadores).

De 9.166 colegios, entre privados y públicos...

803 estudiantes han denunciado ser víctimas de acoso escolar o 'bullying'.

30 estudiantes son insultados, golpeados, abusados sexualmente o humillados con discursos homofóbicos por otros compañeros diariamente.

La mayor incidencia de 'bullying' se registra en Lima, Ayacucho, Puno y Huancavelica.
