 <p>1. NO SHORTCUTS Make sure, when operating tools and machinery, to follow instructions. Procedures exist to keep employees safe.</p>	 <p>2. PPE Make sure you're always wearing the right personal protective equipment, such as a hard hat, goggles, earplugs, and coveralls</p>
 <p>3. KNOW YOUR SURROUNDINGS The more familiar you are with your tasks and workplace, the more aware you'll be of the potential hazards.</p>	 <p>4. REPORT UNSAFE CONDITIONS While your employer is legally required to provide a safe Work place, they may be unaware of any unsafe conditions. If you're aware of anything potentially hazardous, report it to your supervisor.</p>
 <p>5. TAKE A BREAK Our brains just weren't built for the extended focus we demand of it. Give yourself a break to regain focus, and thereby become more aware of your surroundings.</p>
